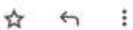

Please find the abstract below, for your information:

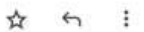
This study aims to reveal the possible benefits of incorporating the four-stage model of competence development into teacher training. First, a historical overview is given about the appearance of the four-stage model starting from the original sources by Broadwell and Burch arriving at today's widespread use in the medical and other professions. The case of the teaching profession and teacher education has almost been untouched in the literature; consequently, it is the right time to raise questions and dilemmas about the strength, usefulness, and applicability of the four-stage competence model. We conclude that teacher education and teachers' continuous professional development training can benefit from considering and taking note of the steps described in the four-stage competence development model. The pedagogical issues of the transitions between the stages may prove to be instructive.

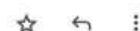
